(B) NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS PART SHALL PREVENT THE DEFENDANT FROM SUMMONING A WITNESS MENTIONED IN THIS PART AS A WITNESS FOR THE DEFENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
