Article - Education Section 17-103 Annotated Code of Maryland (1985 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

17-103.

- (a) The State Board for Higher Education shall determine which institutions are eligible for aid under this subtitle.
- (b) To qualify for State aid under this subtitle, an institution of higher education shall:
 - (1) Be:
- (I) [a] A nonprofit private college or university THAT WAS ESTABLISHED IN THE STATE BEFORE JULY 1, 1970[, or be];
- (II) [a] A nonprofit private institution of higher education that formerly received State aid as a component of a private college or university that was established in this State before July 1, 1970; OR
- (III) A PRIVATE NONPROFIT INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT GRANTS-ONLY-AN-ASSOCIATE-OF-ARTS-DEGREE-THAT-IS APPROVED-FOR-PURPOSES-OF-THIS-PROGRAM-BY-THE-STATE-BOARD-FOR HIGHER-EDUCATION IS ESTABLISHED IN THIS STATE AND GRANTS AN ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE;
- (2) Be approved by the State Board for Higher Education;
 - (3) Be:
- (I) Accredited [accredited] ACCREDITED by the Commission on Higher Education of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools; OR
- (II)--IF---INELIGIBLE--FOR--ACCREDITATION--UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH-(I)-OF-THIS-PARAGRAPH-APPROVED-BY-THE--STATE--BOARD
