- (5)--THE-DEPARTMENT-OR-AN-ORGANIZATION-APPROVED-BY-THE SECRETARY-SHALL--CONDUCT--THE--PROFICIENCY--TESTING--PROGRAM--FOR MEDICAL-LABORATORIES:
- (6) (4) A MEDICAL LABORATORY SHALL PAY THE DEPARTMENT A FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE SECRETARY FOR TO COVER THE COST OF THE STATE CYTOLOGY PROFICIENCY TEST TESTING PROGRAM UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (5) THE DEPARTMENT OR-AN-ORGANIZATION-APPROVED-BY-THE SECRETARY SHALL CONDUCT THE PROFICIENCY TESTING PROGRAM FOR ALL CYTOLOGY LABORATORIES.

17-205.

- (a) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a person shall hold a permit issued by the Secretary before the person may:
 - (1) Operate a medical laboratory in this State; or
- (2) Represent or service in this State any medical laboratory that is outside this State.
- (b) This section does not apply to a physician or a group of not more than 3 physicians. The Secretary may grant an exception to the permit requirements of this subtitle for each group of more than 3 physicians if each physician in the group personally:
- (1) Performs or supervises medical laboratory procedures only for the physician's patients or patients of the group;
- (2) Performs only limited laboratory examinations as set forth by the Secretary under this subtitle's rules and regulations; and
- (3) Continues to meet the requirements under § 17-212 of this subtitle.

17-212.

- (a) A physician or group practice that is exempted from the permit requirements of this subtitle shall:
- (1) Demonstrate satisfactory performance in a proficiency testing program in applicable laboratory procedures before the physician performs any medical laboratory procedure; or
