- THE DIRECTOR OF A MEDICAL LABORATORY IN WHICH SERUM SAMPLES ARE TESTED FOR HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE SECRETARY EVERY MONTH CONTAINING:
- (1) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF SERUM SAMPLES TESTED HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS DURING THE PREVIOUS MONTH AT THE MEDICAL LABORATORY;
- THE TOTAL NUMBER OF SERUM (2) SAMPLES TESTED IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS DURING THE PREVIOUS MONTH AT THE HUMAN MEDICAL LABORATORY WITH CONFIRMED POSITIVE RESULTS: AND
- (3) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF SERUM SAMPLES TESTED FOR IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS DURING THE PREVIOUS MONTH AT THE MEDICAL LABORATORY WITH EQUIVOCAL INDETERMINATE RESULTS.
- (B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH SUBSECTION, THE NUMBERS REQUIRED TO BE REPORTED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL ALSO BE CLASSIFIED ACCORDING TO:
 - (I) AGE;
 - (II) RACE;
 - (III) SEX; AND
 - (IV) COUNTY OF RESIDENCE.
- (2) PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY IF THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1):
 - (I) IS NOT AVAILABLE; OR
- (II) WOULD LEAD TO THE DISCLOSURE OF THE IDENTITY OF AN INDIVIDUAL TESTED FOR HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS AT THE MEDICAL LABORATORY.
- (C) THE MONTHLY REPORT SHALL BE ON THE FORM THAT THE DEPARTMENT PROVIDES.
- (D) THE MONTHLY REPORT MAY NOT DISCLOSE, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, THE IDENTITY OF ANY INDIVIDUAL TESTED FOR HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.
