- (C) THE CHAIRMAN AND THE VICE CHAIRMAN MAY BE REAPPOINTED. 8-304.
- (A) THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL ESTABLISH COMMITTEES ON:
 - (1) ALCOHOL ABUSE: AND
 - (2) DRUG ABUSE.
- (B) MEMBERSHIP OF EACH COMMITTEE SHALL REFLECT EQUAL REPRESENTATION OF BOTH ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE VIEWS.

 - (A) THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL MEET:
- (1) AT LEAST EVERY THIRD MONTH, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT IT DETERMINES; AND
 - (2) AT THE CALL OF ITS CHAIRMAN.
 - (B) A MEMBER OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL:
 - (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

- (A) THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL DOES NOT HAVE ANY EXECUTIVE OR APPOINTIVE DUTIES.
 - (B) THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL:
- (1) BE A STRONG ADVOCATE OF A COMPREHENSIVE, BROAD-BASED APPROACH TO THE SOCIAL, ECONOMIC, PSYCHOLOGICAL, AND MEDICAL HEALTH PROBLEMS OF ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE:
- (2) ADVISE THE GOVERNOR, THE SECRETARY, AND THE ADMINISTRATION ON:
- (I) SHORT AND LONG TERM NEEDS FOR SERVICES WHICH THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL HAS IDENTIFIED;
- (II) PROMOTING AND COORDINATING, IN COOPERATION WITH OTHER FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL OR PRIVATE AGENCIES, UNIFIED
