- (2) The facilities at which the medical examinations are to be done.

An individual may not be committed under Part II of this subtitle if the individual:

- (1) Already is committed to the Administration under court order;
 - (2) Is charged with a crime; or
 - (3) Is confined in a correctional institution.

- (a) An individual who believes himself or herself to be a drug abuser may file a petition to be committed to the Administration, as provided in Part II of this subtitle.
- (b) A petition under this section may be filed with the district court in or circuit court for the county where the individual resides or otherwise may be found.
 - (c) A petition under this section shall:
 - (1) Be signed and verified by the petitioner;
 - (2) State the petitioner's:
 - (i) Name;
 - (ii) Address;
 - (iii) Telephone number, if any;
 - (iv) Birth date;
