- individual for whom commitment is sought [is a drug addict] HAS A DRUG DEPENDENCE, the court shall dismiss the petition and discharge the individual.
- (c) If, after reviewing the report, the court is satisfied that there are reasonable grounds to believe that the individual [is a drug addict] HAS A DRUG DEPENDENCE, the court promptly shall:
 - (1) Give the individual a copy of the report;
- (2) If the individual does not have counsel, advise the individual of the individual's right to counsel; and
 - (3) Advise the individual that:
- (i) The petition and the report set forth reasonable grounds to believe that the individual [is a drug addict] HAS A DRUG DEPENDENCE;
- addict] HAVE A DRUG DEPENDENCE, the individual may be committed to the Administration; and
- (iii) The individual is entitled to a trial before the court or a jury.
- (d) The court immediately shall commit the individual to the Administration if:
- (1) A motion for a trial is not made by or for the individual; and
- (2) The court finds, on clear and convincing evidence, that:
- DRUG DEPENDENCE; (i) The individual [is a drug addict] HAS A
- (ii) The individual needs care, supervision, and treatment because of the drug [addiction] DEPENDENCE;
- (iii) The individual presents a danger to the life or safety of the individual or another; and
- (iv) There is no available less restrictive form of intervention that is consistent with the welfare and safety of the individual.
