passes the first scheduled examination for which the applicant is eligible 7-AND

- (5)--THE-ACTIVITIES--AND--SERVICES--OF--AN--INDIVIDUAL ENGAGED---IN--THE--TEACHING--OF--PSYCHOLOGY--OR--THE--CONDUCT--OF PSYCHOLOGICAL-RESEARCH, -PROVIDED-THAT-SUCH-TEACHING--OR--RESEARCH DOES---NOT---INVOLVE---THE--DELIVERY--OR--SUPERVISION--OF--DIRECT PSYCHOLOGICAL-SERVICES-TO-INDIVIDUALS-OR-GROUPS-OF-INDIVIDUALS.
- (c) If, for good cause, an applicant for a license under subsection (b)(4) of this section is unable to take the first scheduled examination for which the applicant is eligible, the Board may grant an extension to the individual to take the next scheduled examination for which the applicant is eligible.
- (d) The Board may authorize an unlicensed individual to practice psychology, subject to any limitations the Board imposes, if:
- (1) The Board finds that the circumstances warrant; and
  - (2) The individual:
    - (i) Is not a resident of this State; and
- (ii) Meets the qualifications, other than residence and examination, for a license.
- f(e) The exceptions of subsection (b)(1) of this section do not apply to individuals who are employed by the Department, a county health department, the Baltimore City Health Department, or the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services after July 1, 1985. An individual who is employed by any of the departments under this subsection on July 1, 1985 but who is not licensed by the Board shall function under the direct supervision of a licensed psychologist who takes full responsibility for the psychological services provided by the individual.

## 16-312.5.

- (A) IF, IN INVESTIGATING AN ALLEGATION BROUGHT AGAINST A LICENSEE UNDER THIS TITLE, THE BOARD HAS REASON TO BELIEVE THAT THE LICENSEE MAY CAUSE HARM TO PERSONS AFFECTED BY THE LICENSEE'S PRACTICE OF PSYCHOLOGY, THE BOARD, ON ITS OWN INITIATIVE, MAY SHALL DIRECT THE LICENSEE TO SUBMIT TO AN APPROPRIATE EXAMINATION BY A PSYCHOLOGIST OR PHYSICIAN DESIGNATED BY THE BOARD.
- (B) IN RETURN FOR THE PRIVILEGE GIVEN TO A LICENSEE TO PRACTICE PSYCHOLOGY IN THE STATE, THE LICENSEE IS DEEMED TO HAVE:
- (1) CONSENTED TO SUBMIT TO AN EXAMINATION UNDER THIS SECTION, IF REQUESTED BY THE BOARD IN WRITING; AND
