SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

5-202-

(b)(2)(i) -- In this paragraph "average statewide per pupil expenditure" means the average for the third and fourth preceding fiscal years of the statewide aggregate of expenditures for basic current expenses for the fiscal year, divided by the full-time equivalent enrollment on September 30 of the fiscal year. The statewide aggregate of expenditures for basic current expenses shall:

1. -- Exclude disbursements for food subsidy programs and food service, employer contributions to teachers' retirement and social security paid by the State, student body activities, community services, pupil transportation, adult education, school construction, and debt service;

2. -- Include disbursements for instruction, kindergarten through grade 12, pupil personnel services, health services, operation of plant, maintenance of plant, administration, and fixed charges, including teachers' retirement and teachers' social security contributions paid by the subdivisions; and

3. -- Be reduced by the following revenues to the subdivisions: State drivers' education aid, compensatory education funds, State handicapped education aid, all federal aid except that for adult education, food subsidy, school construction, youth services, multiservice centers and any other aid not applicable to the expenditure categories noted in sub-subparagraph 2 of this subparagraph;
