

(ii) The State shall share in an expenditure for basic current expenses equal to the product of the full-time equivalent enrollment and the following amounts:

1. \$1,286 for fiscal year 1985;

2. \$1,449 for fiscal year 1986;

3. \$1,651 for fiscal year 1987;

4. \$1,846 for fiscal year 1988;

5. \$1,999 for fiscal year 1989;

6. \$2,168 for fiscal year 1990;

7. The amount equal to the average statewide per pupil expenditure multiplied by .74, or \$2,352, whichever is the lesser figure, for fiscal year 1991; and

8. The amount equal to the average statewide per pupil expenditure multiplied by .75, or \$2,550, whichever is the lesser figure, for fiscal year 1992.

(iii) In fiscal year 1993 and each year thereafter, the average statewide per pupil expenditure multiplied by .75 is the per pupil basic current expense figure. This figure is multiplied by the full-time equivalent enrollment to determine the basic current expense funding program in which the State shall share.

(5)(i) Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, the State share of basic current expenses for each county is the difference between the county share calculated under paragraph (3) of this subsection and the basic current expense to be shared, as indicated in paragraph (2) of this subsection.

(ii) If the State share of basic current expenses, as calculated under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph, is less than the product of {\$60} 10 PERCENT OF THE PER PUPIL EXPENDITURE FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AS SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (2)(ii) 5 THROUGH 8 AND (iii) OF THIS SUBSECTION \$90 and the county's full-time equivalent enrollment, the State share of basic current expenses for the county shall be the product of {\$60} 10 PERCENT OF THE PER PUPIL EXPENDITURE FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AS SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (2)(ii) 5 THROUGH 8 AND (iii) OF THIS SUBSECTION \$90 and the county's full-time equivalent enrollment.
