In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 12.

This bill provides for changing the name of Salisbury State College to Salisbury State University.

House Bill 18, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 17, 1988, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 12.

AN ACT concerning

State Universities and Colleges - Name Change

FOR the purpose of changing the name of a certain State college;
and providing for a certain contingency.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education
Section 14-101
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1985 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
