AN ACT concerning

Refuse Disposal System Permits -
Notice to Members of the General Assembly

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to notify certain members of the General Assembly at certain times regarding the issuance, renewal, or extension of a permit for a refuse disposal system; and providing for the scope of this Act.
