addition, as was noted by the Attorney General, the injunctive provision of the House bill is broader and permits the injunction of any violation of the Act. Because I agree that this is preferable, I have chosen not to sign Senate Bill 302.

AN ACT concerning

Age Identification Cards and Documents - Sale or Issuance
~~or-issuance~~

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the sale, ~~issue, -issue,~~ or offer for sale or issue or-issuance of any identification card or document containing a ~~person's--age--or--date--of--birth;~~ providing-certain-exceptions; blank space for a person's age or date of birth or an incorrect age or date of birth of a person; providing for -a- certain exception exceptions; providing for injunctive relief and penalties for violators of this Act; and generally relating to the crime of selling, ~~issuing, -issuing,-~~ or offering to sell or issue -or-issuance age identification cards and documents.

BY adding to

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments
Section 233E to be under the new subheading "Age
Identification Cards"
Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

AGE IDENTIFICATION CARDS

233E.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "OFFER FOR SALE" INCLUDES EVERY INDUCEMENT, SOLICITATION, ATTEMPT, OR PRINTED OR MEDIA ADVERTISEMENT INTENDED TO ENCOURAGE A PERSON TO PURCHASE AN IDENTIFICATION CARD.
