VETOES

smear-test-slides-for-2-years requiring that the regulations include certain restrictions and certain requirements with respect to certain practices of cytotechnologists, cytopathologists, and cytology laboratories---; requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to establish and conduct a certain testing program; requiring medical laboratories to pay a certain fee for a certain proficiency testing program; and generally relating to the regulation of certain medical laboratories in the State.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (4) REQUIRE CYTOLOGY LABORATORIES TO RESCREEN NO LESS THAN 10 PERCENT OF ALL NEGATIVE PAP SMEARS;
- A SUPERVISORY LEVEL CYTOTECHNOLOGIST OR A CYTOPATHOLOGIST;
- REQUIRE THE PATHOLOGIST OHW DIRECTS THE LABORATORY TO ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER AN ONGOING CYTOPATHOLOGY QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM WITH STANDARDS RECOGNIZED BY PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATIONS;
