Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 361.

This bill authorizes a municipal corporation, if a county expressly approves, to place annexed land in a zoning classification that permits a substantially different land use.

House Bill 667, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 17, 1988, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 361.
