- (5) (6) Carry out otherwise the purposes and requirements of this [subtitle] PART VII, INCLUDING IMPOSITION OF INTERMEDIATE SANCTIONS TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE; and
- (6) (7) Prohibit a child from remaining at a [group day] CHILD care center for more than 14 hours in 1 day unless the [local health officer] DEPARTMENT issues an exception for that child based on quidelines set by the Secretary.
