- (a) A person who violates any provision of this [subtitle] PART VII or any rule or regulation adopted under it is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500 for the first offense and not exceeding \$1,000 for any subsequent offense.
- (b) Each day that a [group day] CHILD care center operates illegally after a first conviction is a separate offense.

- (A) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW RELATING TO CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT, A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES THAT RECEIVES A REPORT OF SUSPECTED CHILD ABUSE UNDER § 5-703 OR § 5-704 OF THIS TITLE THAT CONCERNS A CHILD CARE CENTER, SHALL NOTIFY THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE.
- (B) ON RECEIPT OF THE NOTIFICATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE SHALL CONVENE A MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM TO COORDINATE PROCEDURES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AGREEMENT DEVELOPED UNDER § 5-706(E) OF THIS TITLE TO BE FOLLOWED IN INVESTIGATING AND OTHERWISE RESPONDING TO THE REPORT.
- (C) THE MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM SHALL BE CHAIRED BY THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE AND SHALL INCLUDE:
- (1) REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT ARE INVESTIGATING THE REPORT UNDER § 5-706 OF THIS TITLE;
- (2) REPRESENTATION FROM THE OFFICE OF THE LOCAL STATE'S ATTORNEY; AND
- (3) APPROPRIATE MEDICAL, INCLUDING MENTAL HEALTH, EXPERTISE.
