Senate Bill No. 546

AN ACT concerning

Parole Commission - Recommendation of Sentencing Judge and Victims in Granting Parole

FOR the purpose of requiring the Parole Commission, if the sentencing judge requests under certain circumstances, to notify the sentencing judge of a parole release hearing; providing that the victim of a violent crime or a designated family member may make a written recommendation to the Parole Commission on the advisability of releasing inmate on parole; requiring the Commission to make certain information available for the inmate's review; requiring the Commission to delete certain information from documents before review by the inmate or the inmate's representative; requiring the Commission to consider the sentencing judge's or the victim's or designated family member's written recommendation and an updated victim impact statement under certain circumstances; requiring Commission to inform the sentencing judge of Commission's final decision under certain circumstances; defining a certain term; and generally relating to requiring certain procedures concerning parole release hearings.
