SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

- (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Board" means the State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners.
- (C) "COMMITTEE" MEANS THE PHYSICAL THERAPIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE.
- [(c)] (D) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the Board to practice:
 - (i) Physical therapy; or
 - (ii) Limited physical therapy:
- [(d)] (E) "Licensed physical therapist" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a physical therapist who is licensed by the Board to practice physical therapy.
- [(e)] (F) "Licensed physical therapist assistant" means; unless the context requires otherwise, a physical therapist assistant who is licensed by the Board to practice limited physical therapy.
- [(f)] (G) "Physical therapist" means an individual who practices physical therapy.
- [(g)] (H) "Physical therapist assistant" means an individual who practices limited physical therapy.
- [(h)] (I) (l) "Practice limited physical therapy" means to practice for compensation the health specialty concerned with:
- (i) The prevention of disability in individuals; and
- (ii) The physical rehabilitation of individuals with a congenital or acquired disability.
- (2) "Practice limited physical therapy" includes, except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, administering treatment with therapeutic exercise; therapeutic massage, mechanical devices, or therapeutic agents that use the physical, chemical, or other properties of air, water, electricity, sound, or radiant energy.
