Article 88A - Social Services Administration Section 6 Annotated Code of Maryland (1985 Replacement Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Family Law

5-528.

- (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- (1) OBTAIN THE MEDICAL HISTORY AND RECORD OF EACH CHILD IN FOSTER CARE;
- (2) PROVIDE THE MEDICAL HISTORY AND RECORD OF A CHILD IN FOSTER CARE TO THE CHILD'S FOSTER CARE PROVIDER; AND
- THAT A ENSURE CHILD IN FOSTER CARE PROMPTLY RECEIVES APPROPRIATE MEDICAL PREVENTIVE CARE, SERVICES, TREATMENT, AND OTHER AND DIAGNOSES APPROPRIATE HEALTH CARE CONSISTENT WITH THE STANDARDS OF THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF PEDIATRICS.
- (B) If the costs are not reimbursable under the Maryland Medical Assistance Program, the Department shall reimburse a foster care provider for payment of the following medical costs for a child under foster care:
 - prescription drugs;
- (2) nonprescription drugs that are recommended by a physician;
 - (3) replacement of eyeglasses; and
- (4) any other service that was covered by regulations under the Maryland Medical Assistance Program on December 31, 1975.
