THE BOARD SHALL PAY ALL MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

(A) (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO PRACTICE HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR CONDITIONING, AND REFRIGERATION CONTRACTING IN THE STATE.

(2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO PROVIDE OR TO ASSIST IN PROVIDING HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR CONDITIONING, AND REFRIGERATION SERVICES BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL MAY ASSIST IN PROVIDING HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR CONDITIONING, AND REFRIGERATION SERVICES IN THE STATE.

(c) (B) THE BOARD SHALL NOT REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING PERSONS INDIVIDUALS TO OBTAIN A LICENSE:

(1) AN INDIVIDUAL OWNER OF A SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLING WHILE THAT OWNER IS PRACTICING HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR CONDITIONING, AND REFRIGERATION SERVICES ON OR WITHIN BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES OWNED BY THE INDIVIDUAL;

(2) AN EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANY REGULATED BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION, WHEN ENGAGED IN:
