(E) SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 14-505 OF THIS TITLE, THE BOARD, ON THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF ITS FULL AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP, MAY REPRIMAND OR PLACE AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC ON PROBATION OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE CERTIFICATION OF AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC FOR ANY CONDUCT PROHIBITED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION OR PROHIBITED UNDER ANY REGULATION ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

(a) To the extent permitted by the rules, regulations, and orders of the Board [and the Commission], an individual to whom duties are delegated by a licensed physician may perform those duties without a license as provided in this section.

(d) (1) If a duty that is to be delegated under this section is a part of the practice of a health occupation that is regulated under this article by another board, any rule or regulation concerning that duty shall be adopted jointly by the Board of [Medical Examiners] MEDICAL PHYSICIAN QUALITY ASSURANCE and the board that regulates the other health occupation.

(2) If the two boards cannot agree on a proposed rule or regulation, the proposal shall be submitted to the Secretary for a final decision.

(e) Subject to the requirements of the Administrative Procedure Act, the [Commission] BOARD on the affirmative vote of its full authorized membership, may reprimand a restricted license holder, may place any restricted license holder on probation, or suspend or revoke a restricted license for any of the grounds for [Commission] BOARD action under § 14-504 of this title.
