AN ACT concerning

Highway User Revenues - Baltimore City

FOR the purpose of permitting a certain use of highway user funds by Baltimore City for certain fiscal years.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Transportation Section 8-408(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (1977 Volume and 1987 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
