EXECUTIVE ORDERS

- D. On September 1, 1987, the responsibility for administration of any unexpected or carry over funds derived from formula or discretionary grants authorized by the Act shall be transferred from the Juvenile Services Agency to the Governor's Office for Children and Youth:
- (1) On and after September 1, 1987, the Governor's Office for Children and Youth shall exercise all functions related to the fiscal administration of the Act as provided in the budget; and
- (2) The fiscal administration of the Act refers to such functions as meeting annual planning requirements, financial accountability, financial audit, and monitoring and evaluation of subgrants.
- E. The Governor's Office for Children and Youth shall administer such operating funds as the Council is entitled to under Section 222 of the Act:
- (1) The Governor's Office for Children and Youth with the advice of the chairman of the Council, may hire a staff person(s) to provide such support and perform such duties as deemed appropriate. The staff to the Council will report to the Director of the Governor's Office for Children and Youth; and
- (2) The Governor's Office for Children and Youth may provide the Council with such additional staff support, services and technical assistance as necessary and as provided in the State budget.
- F. This Executive Order is effective immediately.
