any and all allocations, apportionments. determinations, or findings required or permitted by this Proclamation. The Secretary may delegate such authority to the Deputy Secretary of Economic and [Community] EMPLOYMENT Development. Āny allocations, apportionments, determinations, and findings of the Secretary shall be made his sole and absolute discretion, subject to the provisions of this Proclamation, and shall be conclusive, and shall not be subject to review or approval (1) [(a)] under either the Maryland Administrative Procedure Act or any other law of the State of Maryland, or (2) [(b)] by any agency or political subdivision of the State of Maryland. THE SECRETARY SHALL TAKE ACTIONS UNDER SECTION B. (4)(B) [2(D)(2)], SECTION F [6] AND SECTION H [8] OF PROCLAMATION ONLY AFTER CONSULTING WITH THE SECRETARY OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.

B. [Section 2.] <u>Initial Allocations</u>. The Maryland State Ceiling shall be <u>initially allocated</u> for the period from the date hereof through September 30, 1987 as follows:

(1) [(a)] Counties.

- (A) [(1)] There is hereby initially allocated among those Local Issuers which are counties of the State of Maryland and the City of Baltimore (collectively, the "Counties" and individually a "County") a total of 40 percent of the Maryland State Ceiling, consisting of (I)[(a)] 25 percent of the Maryland State Ceiling designated initially for the issuance of qualified mortgage bonds and bonds for qualified residential rental projects (as defined in the Tax Reform Act, and together referred to herein as "Housing Bonds") and (II)[(b)] 15 percent of the Maryland State Ceiling designated for the issuance of Private Activity Bonds other than Housing Bonds.
 - (B) [(2)] The allocation to each County for Housing Bonds shall equal 25 percent of the Maryland State Ceiling multiplied by a fraction, the numerator of which is the population of the County and the denominator of which is the population of the State of Maryland.
 - (C) [(3)] The allocation to each County for bonds other than Housing Bonds shall be in the following amounts:
