RESOLUTION NO. 154

BE IT RESOLVED; that the Charter of the Town of Centreville be amended as follows:

Section 202 of the Charter of the Town of Centreville is hereby amended by adding, the words "Any Council member who ceases to reside in the town during his or her term of office shall immediately resign, terminating his or her membership on the Town Council. The vacancy created by the resignation of any council member's position shall be filled as set forth in Section 414 of this Charter"; the said Section to hereafter read as follows:
