Sup.) for the enlargement of the corporate boundaries of said Town by the annexation of certain land contiguous to and adjoining the existing corporate area by amending the provision of the Code of Cecil County, Maryland, Chapter 27, which incorporates the Charter of the Town of Elkton and constituting an amendment to the municipal charter of the body politic and corporate known as the Town of Elkton.
