A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF NEW CARROLLTON, PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND (SECTION 9 OF ARTICLE 17 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND, EVERSTINE'S 1963 EDITION, AS AMENDED) AMENDING SUBSECTION 7.b., ENTITLED "NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES," OF SECTION 7 of Said CHARTER, ENTITLED "ELECTIONS," TO PROVIDE THAT NOMINATING PETITIONS FOR ANY ELECTIVE OFFICE SHALL BE FILED NO LATER THAN FIVE O'CLOCK P.M. OF THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY, INCLUDING SUNDAYS AND LEGAL HOLIDAYS, PRIOR TO A GENERAL OR SPECIAL ELECTION; TO PROVIDE THAT CANDIDATES WHO HAVE FILED PETITIONS OF CANDIDACY MAY WITHDRAW THEIR CANDIDACY AND THAT THE NAMES OF CANDIDATES FOR ANY
