### RESOLUTION

A Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Market, a body corporate and politic of the State of Maryland, dated April 8, 1987, and introduced at a regular meeting of the Mayor and council to provide for the enlargement of the corporate boundaries of the Town of New Market by extending the corporate limits of the Town and in so doing to repeal and re-enact with amendments that resolution of the Town of New Market which was introduced at a meeting of the Mayor and council of the Town of New Market, held December 14, 1977, on which a public hearing was held on March 8, 1978, and which was passed at a meeting of said Mayor and council on March 8, 1978, effective April 22, 1978, regarding the corporate boundaries of said town; providing as to the conditions and circumstances applicable to the change in boundaries to the residents and property within the area to be annexed; further providing for notice thereof of a public hearing to be held by the Mayor and council, the effective date of the resolution, if adopted, and the registration of boundaries as set forth in Article 23 A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1981 Replacement Volume.
