CHARTER RESOLUTION AMENDMENT NO. 1987-1

SUBJECT: "Referendum."

Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of Ocean City, Maryland, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland, and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1957 edition as amended, to amend the Charter of the Town of Ocean City, Maryland, the amendment to be entitled: "Referendum" by repealing and reenacting with amendment to certain section of the Charter of the Town of Ocean City, Maryland. This amendment shall have the effect of providing that an emergency ordinance shall be effective for sixty (60) days following receipt of a referendum petition.
