AN ACT to add new Chapter 218, heading, Sheriff, to the Harford County Code, as amended, to provide a chapter of laws which will govern the Sheriff's Department; to enact new Article I, heading, Disposition of Unclaimed Property, to be added to new Chapter 218 of the Harford County Code, said Article I to empower the Sheriff of Harford County to sell at public auction all unclaimed property; to provide for advertisement of such sale; to require the Sheriff to make reasonable efforts to locate the owners of all such property prior to a sale and give notice thereof; to allow the Sheriff to dispose of all bicycles either by public sale or gift to any charitable, nonprofit, or eleemosynary agency or institution in Harford County; to allow the Sheriff to withhold from sale any property and establish regulations therefore; and to provide for the payoff of the net proceeds of all such funds to the General Fund of Harford County.

AN ACT to add new Subsection A.(3) to Section 219-14, heading, Prohibited Signs, of Chapter 219, heading, Signs, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to prohibit the posting of signs on property owned, leased, or controlled by a public utility, unless posting has been authorized by the utility.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsections B, C, D, E, and F of Section 1-29, heading, County-Owned Property; and to add new subsections G and H to the same Section 1-29, heading, County-Owned Property, of Article III, heading, General Administration, of Chapter I, heading, General Provisions, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide for the disposition of County-owned real property declared to be surplus; requiring that such surplus real property be disposed of at public auction; exempting certain types of real property and
