AND SEWAGE PUMPING STATIONS AND TO ESTABLISH BUFFER YARD REQUIREMENTS WITH RESPECT THERETO, TO PROVIDE THAT PUBLIC UTILITY FACILITIES AND SEWAGE PUMPING STATIONS ARE PRINCIPAL PERMITTED USES IN THE ORI DISTRICT, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS BILL SHALL NOT APPLY TO THE EXPANSION OF SEWAGE PUMPING STATIONS EXISTING AS OF THE DATE OF ENACTMENT OF THIS BILL.
