Emergency Bill No. 7-87

Chapter 40

Laws of Montgomery County, 1987

AN EMERGENCY ACT:

- (1) To provide that one member of the board of investment trustees may be (i) a member of the retirement system and represented by an employee organization or, (ii) an employee of an employee organization, or (iii) a person recommended by an employee organization; and
- (2) To generally amend the provisions regarding the appointment of trustees.
