

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY

Temporary Intergovernmental Transfers  
of County Employees

FOR the purpose of (1) authorizing appointing authorities to recommend, subject to the approval of the Chief Administrative Officer and the consent of the employee, the transfer of County employees to agencies, departments and offices of the United States, the State of Maryland, counties and municipalities of the State of Maryland, and not for profit agencies that receive County funds for temporary periods not to exceed one year; (2) establishing procedures for such transfers; (3) providing for the limited extension of such transfers; and (4) providing for retroactive application.
