FOR the purpose of authorizing policy mutual aid agreements and providing for the furnishing of police personnel and equipment to other counties, municipal corporations or jurisdictions beyond the territorial limits of the county under certain circumstances; and validating and continuing certain existing agreements.

BY adding:

SUBTITLE 18. POLICE.
