625. RECORDS BY COMMON CARRIER.

IF REQUIRED BY REGULATION, A COMMON CARRIER OF CIGARETTES THAT ARE SHIPPED INTO THE STATE SHALL FILE A COPY OF THE FREIGHT BILL RELATING TO THE CIGARETTE SHIPMENT WITH THE COMPTROLLER.

626. RECORDS BY SUBWHOLESALE AND WHOLESALE.

(A) RECORDS REQUIRED BY SUBWHOLESALE AND WHOLESALE.

EACH SUBWHOLESALE AND WHOLESALE SHALL:

(1) OBTAIN AN INVOICE FOR EACH PURCHASE OF ANY CIGARETTES;

(2) KEEP A RECEIVING RECORD FOR ALL CIGARETTES RECEIVED, TO WHICH THE SUBWHOLESALE AND WHOLESALE SHALL POST EACH DAY:

- (I) THE INVOICE NUMBER;
- (II) THE DATE OF RECEIPTS;
- (III) THE QUANTITY RECEIVED;
- (IV) THE BRAND; AND

(V) THE NAME OF THE PERSON FROM WHOM THE CIGARETTES ARE RECEIVED;

(3) FOR CIGARETTE SALES TO RETAILERS:

(I) KEEP A RECORD OF THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF EACH RETAILER TO WHOM A SALE IS MADE; AND
