

- (1) A design for a safe environment for children;
 - (2) Activities designed to meet a child's individual physical, social, emotional, and intellectual needs;
 - (3) Year-round programming for the following times:
 - (i) Before- and after-school;
 - (ii) A school holiday; AND
 - (iii) A day when school is closed for weather or summer vacation[.];
 - (4) Recommendations to implement § 7-109 of the Education Article;
 - (5) Local zoning laws that affect the development of the [plan] NEEDS ASSESSMENT;
 - (6) Training opportunities for providers of child care; and
 - (7) Appropriate funding mechanisms.
- (d) The Governor shall appoint a child care coordinator who shall:
- (1) Provide information to counties concerning child care needs;
 - (2) Provide guidance and technical assistance to each county;
 - (3) Establish a liaison with each county agency designated to conduct the needs assessment;
 - (4) Coordinate efforts with State agencies to increase awareness of local child care issues; and
 - (5) Review and report on recommendations for the implementation of the [plan] NEEDS ASSESSMENT.
