- (2) Except for the ex officio [member] MEMBERS and the members representing the Chesapeake Bay Seafood Industries Association, the Governor shall appoint each member with the advice of the Secretary; and
- (3) Except for the ex officio [member] MEMBERS, each member appointed by the Governor shall be appointed with the advice and consent of the Senate.
