(2) does not meet the current requirements for a new license.

(a) A person who violates any provision of this Part VII OF THIS SUBTITLE or any rule or regulation adopted under it is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500 for the first offense and not exceeding \$1,000 for any subsequent offense.

(a) In addition to any other provision of law relating to child abuse and neglect, a local department of social services that receives a report of suspected child abuse under [§ 5-703] § 5-704 or [§ 5-704] § 5-705 of this title that concerns a child care center, shall notify the Secretary's designee.
