(d) Any support order or modification of support order that is passed on or after July 1, 1985, and any notice and statement issued under [paragraph (b)(2)] SUBSECTION (B)(2) of this section shall include a statement that:

(1) if the obligor accumulates support payments arrears amounting to more than 30 days of support, the obligor shall be subject to earnings withholding;
