

SECTION 25. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the initial overall plan required to be adopted by the Board of Regents of the University of Maryland System under [§ 12-1069(a)] § 12-106(A) of the Education Article, as enacted by this Act, shall be prepared by the Board by July 1, 1989.

SECTION 32. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Scholarship Administration shall conduct a study on the need for expanding the priority for participation in the Loan Assistance Repayment Program, beyond legal services, to other public nonprofit sector services for which there is a shortage of professionals, including, but not limited to: social work, nursing, and teaching. The Administration shall report its [fundings] FINDINGS to the General Assembly by January 1, 1989.
