this subtitle, the Board shall send the applicant a notice that states:

- (1) the applicant has qualified for the license; and
- (2) the Board will issue the license to an applicant on receipt of:
- (i) if contracting in the name of the applicant or another person to provide plumbing services, proof of the liability insurance as required under § 3-501 of this title; and
 - (ii) a license fee of:
- 1. [\$30] \\$75 for a master plumber license or a limited master plumber license; or
- 2. [\$15] \$30 for a journey plumber license or a limited journey plumber license.
 3-308.
- (c) Before the license expires, the licensee may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:
 - (1) otherwise is entitled to be granted a license;
 - (2) pays to the Board a renewal fee of:
- (i) $\{\$50\}$ \$75 for a master plumber license or a limited master plumber license;
- (ii) [\$20] \$30 for a journey plumber license or a limited journey plumber license; or
- (iii) [\$10] \$15 for an apprentice plumber license; and
 - (3) submits to the Board:
- (i) if contracting in the name of the licensee or another person to provide plumbing services, proof of the liability insurance required under \S 3-501 of this title; and
- (ii) a renewal application on the form that the Board provides.
