REGULATIONS REGARDING THE ANNUAL REPORT REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

- (A) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (B) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF § 10-101(E)(2)(I) OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION, OTHER THAN REGULATIONS PERTAINING ONLY TO ROUTINE INTERNAL MANAGEMENT OF THE INSTITUTION, SHALL COMPLY WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.
- (C) REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION BY THE SECRETARY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT SHALL INCLUDE REGULATIONS GOVERNING:
