4-309. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

(A) NOTICE TO QUALIFIED APPLICANTS.

IF AN APPLICANT QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD SHALL SEND THE APPLICANT A NOTICE THAT STATES THAT:

- (1) THE APPLICANT HAS QUALIFIED FOR A LICENSE; AND
- (2) THE BOARD WILL ISSUE THE LICENSE TO THE APPLICANT, ON RECEIPT OF A LICENSE FEE OF:
 - (I) \$10 FOR A MASTER BARBER LICENSE;
 - (II) \$10 FOR A JOURNEY BARBER LICENSE;
 - (III) \$25 FOR A BARBER TEACHER LICENSE;
- (IV) \$10 FOR AN ASSISTANT BARBER TEACHER LICENSE; OR
 - (V) \$10 FOR AN ASSISTANT-BARBER LICENSE.
