## Ch. 28

- (1) Adopt regulations governing:
- (i) The administration of general anesthesia by a licensed dentist;
- (ii) The administration of parenteral sedation by a licensed dentist;
- (iii) The use of a dental assistant by a licensed dentist in performing intraoral procedures;
- (iv) The issuance of a permit to a facility NOT OTHERWISE REGULATED where a [licensed] dentist administers or has GENERAL anesthesia OR PARENTERAL SEDATION administered; [and]
- (v) The issuance of a permit to a [facility
  where a licensed] dentist WHO administers or has GENERAL
  ANESTHESIA OR parenteral sedation administered;
- (VI) REASONABLE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRAINING AND EVALUATION OF A DENTIST BEFORE THE DENTIST MAY ADMINISTER GENERAL ANESTHESIA OR PARENTERAL SEDATION; AND
- (VII) THE DISCIPLINE OF A HOLDER OF ANY FACILITY OR ADMINISTRATIVE ADMINISTRATION PERMIT FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF GENERAL ANESTHESIA OR PARENTERAL SEDATION.
- (2) After consulting with the State Board of Pharmacy, adopt regulations regarding the dispensing of prescription drugs by a licensed dentist; and
- (3) On receipt of a written and signed complaint, investigate an alleged violation of this title.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July June 1, 1989.
