- A. (1) The Commissioners shall meet for the transaction of business:
- (i) On Tuesday and Wednesday of each week, excluding legal holidays;
- $\qquad \qquad \text{(ii)} \quad \text{At a public place designated for its} \\ \text{meetings;} \\$
- (iii) Provided public notice of the change is given at least 7 days prior to a meeting in at least 2 newspapers of general circulation in the county, on any other day that the PRESIDENT OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OR A MAJORITY OF THE County Commissioners determine.
- (2) The County Commissioners may conduct an emergency closed meeting as authorized under § 10-508 of the State Government Article.
- (3) Notwithstanding paragraphs (1) or (2) of this subsection, the County Commissioners may cancel meetings because of:
  - (i) Illness;
  - (ii) Vacations; or
  - (iii) Any other reasonable cause.
- (4) The County Commissioners shall give notice, in accordance with  $\S$  10-506 of the State Government Article, of:
- (i) The day, place, and time that the County Commissioners meet; and
  - (ii) The cancellation of scheduled meetings.
- B. The salary of the 'President of the [Charles] County Commissioners [shall be as follows] IS:
- (1) [Twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000.) per year] \$32,500 for the calendar year [1987.] 1991;
- (2) [Twenty-nine thousand dollars (\$29,000) per year] \$34,000 for the calendar year [1988.] 1992;
- (3) [Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.) per year] \$35,500 for the calendar year [1989.] 1993; AND
- (4) [Thirty-one thousand dollars (\$31,000) per year] \$37,000 for the calendar year [1990] 1994.
