4-403. REGISTRATION AND ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE.

THE BOARD SHALL REGISTER AS A STUDENT AND ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION TO EACH APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

4-404. SCOPE OF REGISTRATION.

(A) IN GENERAL.

WHILE REGISTRATION AS A STUDENT IS IN EFFECT, THE REGISTRATION AUTHORIZES THE INDIVIDUAL:

(1) TO ENROLL AND PARTICIPATE AS A STUDENT IN A BARBER SCHOOL THAT HOLDS A SCHOOL PERMIT; AND

(2) TO PRACTICE BARBERING AT THE BARBER SCHOOL.

(B) CONDITIONS.

(1) A STUDENT SHALL PRACTICE BARBERING ONLY AT THE BARBER SCHOOL.

(2) A STUDENT MAY NOT BE PAID FOR WORK AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION.

In subsection (a)(1) of this section, the reference to a barber school "that holds a school permit" is added to conform to § 4-602 of this title.
