SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland shall read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations

5-611.

- (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding $\{\$25\}$ \$250 \$100.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989 and remain in effect until the taking effect of Section 2.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect October 1, 1989, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1989. However, if Chapter does not become effective, then Section 2 of this Act may not take effect and shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.
