SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

33A.

- (A) THE FREDERICK COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A STADIUM BEER ON-SALE LICENSE TO THE OWNER OF ANY PROFESSIONAL BASEBALL TEAM FRANCHISE, WHETHER THE FRANCHISE IS A PARTNERSHIP OR CORPORATION.
- (B) THE STADIUM BEER ON-SALE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO SELL BEER AT THE STADIUM IN WHICH THE BASEBALL TEAM PLAYS ITS HOME GAMES ONLY UNDER THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:
- (1) IN PLASTIC, STYROFOAM, OR PAPER CONTAINERS ON THE STADIUM PREMISES;
 - (2) FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES;
- (3) TO PERSONS PRESENT AT A BASEBALL GAME IN WHICH THE LICENSEE'S TEAM IS PLAYING; AND
- (4) FROM THE TIME THE STADIUM OPENS FOR THE GAME UNTIL THE GAME ENDS.
- (C) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE STADIUM BEER ON-SALE LICENSE IS 5500.
- (D) EXCEPT FOR A MANUFACTURER OR DISTRIBUTOR OF BEER WHO IS CONDUCTING BUSINESS WITH THE LICENSEE FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE LICENSEE MAY NOT PERMIT ANY PERSON TO:
- (1) CARRY ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ONTO THE LICENSED PREMISES; OR
- (2) CARRY ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
