SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

7-204.

- (a) (1) Except in the District Court, except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection for Baltimore County, and except as otherwise provided in this section, an attorney-at-law is entitled to demand and receive the following fees:
- (i) For bringing, prosecuting, or defending any action at law in a court of original jurisdiction -- \$5;
- (ii) For prosecuting or defending any action, including the collection of money due on mortgage, in a court of equity -- \$10;
- (iii) For prosecuting or defending a case in the Court of Appeals -- \$10;
- (iv) For prosecuting or defending a criminal case if the punishment for the offense charged is death or confinement in the penitentiary -- \$10; and
  - (v) In all other criminal cases -- \$5.
- (X) (1) IN CALVERT COUNTY, THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT SHALL DEPOSIT MONTHLY ALL APPEARANCE FEES COLLECTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION INTO A SPECIAL ACCOUNT TO BE KNOWN AS THE CALVERT COUNTY LAW LIBRARY FUND.
- (2) THE FUND SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR THE ACQUISITION OF BOOKS AND OTHER PUBLICATIONS, LIBRARY EQUIPMENT, AND OTHER NECESSARY EXPENSES, AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
